

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

MINISTRY OF ECONOMIC AFFAIRS, TAIWAN

AND

NATIONAL COLLEGE OF TECHNICAL

PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION OF ESTADO DE

MÉXICO

(CONALEP ESTADO DE MÉXICO)

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into between Ministry of Economic Affairs, Taiwan (hereinafter referred to as MOEA) and National College of Technical Professional Education of Estado de México (hereinafter referred to as CONALEP Estado de México).

Whereas the two contracting Parties have the mutually beneficial interests in cooperating in the area of talent recruitment, and whereas the foundation of the mutual interests would be reinforced by the signing of an agreement to establish a long-term partnership.

It is therefore agreed by MOEA, represented by Y. P. Lien, the Director General of the Department of Investment Services, MOEA, and CONALEP Estado de México, represented by Lic. Edgar Tello Baca, the Director General; that each Party confirms the intention as follows:

1. Each Party will designate a unit and contact window to be responsible for the promotion, coordination, liaison, and handling of relevant matters;
2. Each Party will recommend its subsidiary organizations (agencies, social groups, etc.), scholars, and experts to facilitate the follow-up implementation of professional exchange;
3. Jointly implement matchmaking works, as follows:
 - (1) Each Party will take the initiative in carrying out the exchange of recruitment information between graduates of CONALEP Estado de México and enterprises in Taiwan. This exchange will encompass information that the two sides can provide on corporate job vacancies, personal resumes, and recruitment services.
 - (2) Each Party will inform each other about, or assist in the provision of, recruitment meetings between enterprises and potential employees or similar recruitment activities.
 - (3) CONALEP Estado de México will recommend graduates interested in working in Taiwan, for which the MOEA will provide customized placement services when appropriate. When

CONALEP Estado de México organizes groups of graduates to travel to Taiwan, MOEA will help arrange face-to-face meetings with enterprises in Taiwan when appropriate.

4. Each Party will promote other talent exchange activities such as mutual visits and exchange by CONALEP Estado de México and enterprises in Taiwan, and transnational projects.
5. This MOU is an expression of cooperative relations and is not intended to create any legal obligations under domestic or international law between the Parties.

This MOU shall enter into force on the date of its signing by the representatives of both Parties, and shall remain valid for five years, with automatic renewal, unless written notice of termination is given by one Party to the other no less than three months prior to the date of its expiration.


